RED STAG CHILE

South America's most exclusive free-range stag hunts

Our Chilean program offers a truly unique opportunity to hunt for the enormous Red Stag that roam this part of Southern Chile. A combination of abundant food and great habitat along with more than 80 years of selective herd management, produces some of the largest wild stags in the world, comparable only to certain regions of Eastern Europe, with many of these trophy bulls making the record books over the years.

These Chilean stags are completely wild and all hunts are fair chase on an unfenced ranch. No more than eight mature stags are harvested annually, so the opportunity to hunt these stags are in high demand. Each hunter will be accompanied by an individual guide. These experts are all members of the same family and have an intimate knowledge of the area. The terrain includes valley, rolling hills, and wheat fields interspersed with thick stands of dark timber.

WHY CHOOSE RED STAG CHILE?

- Red Stag Chile is the most exclusive red stag hunting venue in South America, offering extremely limited access to some of the largest, wild, free-range red stags in all of the world.
- The ranch and all hunting is family run, your guides and hosts are the owners, and have an intimate knowledge of the areas and the animals that is second to none. They will work with you to locate and glass animals in order to find the best, mature specimens for you to harvest.
- You will be pursuing mature red stags, with harvested animals being over 9 years of age along with massive body size and antlers to match. The management program which has been in place for nearly 80 years ensures incredible specimens are taken, year after year. The fee is a Flat Rate, and will not change based upon the size of the animal harvested.
- Located in the Lake District of Chilean Patagonia, the ranch encompasses over 20,000 acres of pristine agricultural ground and woodlands, creating the perfect environment for the stags to develop into some of the largest, truly wild specimens roaming the earth today.
- The hills and countryside offer a more physically relaxed hunt as compared to some of the more rugged areas in the country.
- In addition to spot and stalk, there are also options to hunt from European style elevated stands as well.



The 'Fundo,' as Chileans refer to their ranches, is built from local stone and wood, overlooking Rupanco Lake, adjacent volcanoes, and the main hunting grounds.



GETTING THERE

To get to the lodge you need to fly into Santiago de Chile (SCL), which is served with daily direct flights from many U.S. or European cities. Once there, you'll take a 1.30 hour flight to Osorno Airport (ZOS). Hunters will then be picked up at the airport by the lodge staff, and transferred to the lodge along roads with stunning views of the Andes Mountains to the west. The drive to the lodge is 1.30 hour approximately. Helicopter transfers can also be arranged between the airport and the ranch, which take about 20 minutes.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Your accommodation is a beautiful mountain house where the owners personally attend to small groups of guests. Built from local stone and wood, the lodge offers breathtaking views of the mountains, the lake, and the main hunting grounds. In the evenings, guests can indulge in traditional asados (BBQ) and savor delicious home-cooked meals accompanied by fine Chilean wines.

The lodge can accommodate up to 4 people at a time, with a maximum of 2 hunters and 2 non-hunters. For non-hunters, there are various activities available, such as horseback riding, hiking, fishing, sightseeing tours, and even helicopter flights. The lodge has a dedicated team of housekeeping staff, and laundry service is available.

The lodge has 3 en suite rooms with Queen beds.

Thanks to our partnership with one of the finest custom rifle makers in the world, Griffin & Howe, we can offer their Highlander Rifles in .300 Win Mag, as well as a collection of Remington, Sako & Styer rifles in various calibers as well. All guns sport high quality optics including Zeiss, Swarovski, Schmith & Bender, etc.
- Non-hunting activities: horseback riding, sightseeing tour, bird watching, hiking, and more.

THE HUNTING

The hunting season in our area runs from the beginning of March to late April, but we have limited the season to the peak of the rut, which typically occurs in late March to early April. During this time, we only harvest around 8 stags per season, ensuring sustainable management practices. All hunting in Chile is conducted with a 1×1 guide-to-hunter ratio, and our head guide and host is the owner of the ranch.

Additionally, we have European-style elevated stands strategically placed in prime hunting areas, offering the option for still hunting. We have a strict policy of harvesting only mature old stags that have passed their reproductive years. Our herd management plan is of utmost importance to us. After the hunt, we take care of all trophy preparations in accordance with international export requirements. It's worth noting that the property also boasts a healthy population of Fallow Deer and Mouflon sheep.

Mornings begin early with a wake-up call well before daylight, followed by breakfast. Afterward, a short ride will position you in the designated hunting area before sunrise. The hunting areas are conveniently located near the lodge, with travel times never exceeding 30 minutes. We have well-maintained roads on the property, primarily using trucks for transportation. However, for accessing remote spots or if hunters prefer, we also offer horseback hunting. The final stalks are always done on foot.

You will hunt until mid-morning, and then return to the lodge for lunch and a chance to rest or enjoy a siesta. The evening hunt continues until dusk, when you will return to the lodge for cocktails, dinner, and overnight accommodations.

Spotting and stalking is the most common method of hunting for rifle hunters. Archery hunters may also spend some time sitting over wallows and watering areas, awaiting the stag to come in.

We only harvest mature old stags that are coming out of their reproductive life. We take very seriously the heard management plan. After the hunt we take care of all the trophy preparation according to the international export requirements. We don't have a point scale system in Chile, it's a flat fee no matter the size of your Stag.
