RED STAG COLLUN-CO

Central european hunting tradition in Argentine style

This iconic 62,000-acre Patagonian ranch is located near Junín de los Andes, extending from the high-desert foothills of the Andes in the east to the rugged mountains bordering Lanín National Park in the west, close to the Chilean border. It was on this very property that red deer from Eastern Europe were first introduced to Patagonia more than a century ago. Today, the stags remain entirely wild and free-roaming, following the same natural migration routes they have traveled for generations.

Estancia Collun-Co was established in 1909 by German immigrant Robert Hohmann, and the property has remained in the family ever since. The main ranch house, built in 1912, has been carefully restored and modernized while retaining its original character. The hunting lodge is located at the heart of the estancia. This beautiful and welcoming German-style wooden house offers exceptional views of the surrounding mountains and provides a comfortable retreat in one of Patagonia's most dramatic wilderness settings. As with all our hunting properties, Collun-Co follows a strict herd-management program. We harvest only fully mature stags that have reached or passed the peak of their reproductive lives. During the rut, these magnificent mountain deer descend from the remote high cordillera into the ranch in search of hinds, offering an authentic and challenging fair-chase hunting experience.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

The hunting lodge is located at the ranch headquarters, in the heart of the estancia. This beautiful and welcoming German-style wooden house offers outstanding views of the surrounding mountains and provides a comfortable retreat after a day in the field.

Chapelco Airport (CPC), serving San Martín de los Andes, is located just 30 minutes from the ranch and offers daily connections with Buenos Aires. San Carlos de Bariloche Airport (BRC) is approximately four hours away and also receives multiple daily flights from Buenos Aires and other major hubs.

The lodge accommodates up to five hunters and five non-hunting companions. A wide range of activities is available within the property, including horseback riding, hiking, birdwatching, and trout fishing. Miles of the renowned Chimehuín and Quilquihue rivers flow through the ranch, and guided fly-fishing outings can easily be arranged for both hunting and non-hunting guests.

LOCATION

Estancia Collun-Co is located near Junín de los Andes, in Neuquén Province, just 20 miles from Chapelco Airport (CPC).

The world-renowned Chimehuín River forms the property's eastern boundary, while to the west, the ranch borders Lanín National Park for more than 30 miles.



GETTING THERE

Chapelco Airport (CPC), serving San Martín de los Andes, is located just 30 minutes from the lodge and offers daily flights from Buenos Aires Aeroparque.

Alternatively, guests may fly into San Carlos de Bariloche Airport (BRC), approximately three and a half hours from the lodge. Bariloche receives multiple daily flights from Buenos Aires and other regional hubs.

- Fly to Chapelco Airport (CPC), located just 30 minutes from the lodge, with daily service from Buenos Aires Aeroparque (AEP).
- Fly to San Carlos de Bariloche Airport (BRC), approximately three and a half hours from the lodge, with daily connections from Buenos Aires and other regional hubs.

THE HUNTING

At Estancia Collun-Co, as at all our big-game hunting destinations, our goal is to deliver exceptional hunting experiences in some of South America's most beautiful and pristine wilderness settings. Through a strict herd-management program, we limit the annual harvest to a highly exclusive number of mature trophy stags, preserving the quality of the herd and the unique character of the hunt.

Guiding is conducted on a one-to-one basis unless otherwise requested. Each hunter and guide uses the ranch's extensive road network and 4WD vehicles to access the day's hunting area. Horses may also be used, when necessary, particularly to reach the more remote and elevated sections of the property. Travel times from the lodge generally range from 15 minutes to one hour. The primary hunting method is classic spot-and-stalk. Depending on conditions and the time of season, bowhunters may also hunt from carefully selected positions near wallows and watering areas.

Following the morning hunt, guests return to the lodge for lunch and time to relax before heading back into the field in the mid-afternoon. Evening hunts continue until dark, allowing enough time for a safe descent from the mountains. On days when hunters remain in the field throughout the day, packed lunches are provided.

In addition to red stag hunting, the ranch supports a healthy population of fully wild European boar, offering an exciting addition to the Collun-Co hunting experience.



At Estancia Collun-Co, each hunt is defined by low pressure, one-to-one guiding, and classic spot-and-stalk hunting in true Patagonian Mountain country. With only a limited number of mature trophy stags harvested each season, the experience remains personal, selective, and deeply connected to the land.

Round-trip transfers from Chapelco Airport (CPC), shared-room accommodations, all meals, wine and beer, one-to-one guiding, basic trophy preparation, and one red stag trophy with no size limit.

NOT INCLUDED
Airfare; gratuities for guides, skinners, and lodge staff; firearm import permits; rifle rental and ammunition (\$450 per hunt); hunting license and tag (\$495); additional trophy stag (\$7,500) or cull stag (\$2,500), subject to availability; trophy export documentation and sanitary certificates; trophy shipping; wild boar—tusker male (\$1,800), sow, young boar, & piglets (\$550); fishing outside the ranch; professionally guided fishing within the ranch; other optional activities; personal expenses; excess baggage charges; personal and baggage insurance; and any costs resulting from itinerary changes requested by the guest.

PAYMENT TERMS
A 50% non-refundable deposit is required within 14 days of booking. The remaining balance is due 90 days prior to arrival. As a small operation that books far in advance, all payments are non-refundable. However, if we are able to resell the cancelled dates, the amount recovered will be applied as a credit toward a future trip. We strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance.
