RED STAG CHILE

South America's most exclusive free-range stag hunts

Our Chilean program offers a rare opportunity to pursue some of the largest wild red stags in the world, roaming freely across this remarkable region of southern Chile.

An abundance of natural forage, exceptional habitat, and more than 80 years of selective herd management have produced truly remarkable animals. The quality of these stags is comparable only to that found in select regions of Eastern Europe, with numerous trophies entering the record books over the years.

These Chilean stags are entirely wild, and every hunt is conducted under true fair-chase conditions on a vast, unfenced ranch. To protect the quality of the herd and preserve the exclusivity of the experience, no more than eight mature trophy stags are harvested each season. As a result, hunting opportunities are extremely limited and highly sought after.

Each hunter is accompanied by a dedicated guide on a one-to-one basis. The guides are members of the same local family and possess an intimate knowledge of the ranch, its wildlife, and the movements of the herd. The varied terrain includes broad valleys, rolling hills, open wheat fields, and dense stands of dark timber, creating a diverse and challenging hunting environment.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Guests stay in a beautiful mountain lodge where the owners personally host small groups, creating an intimate and highly personalized experience. Built from local stone and timber, the lodge offers breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains, the lake, and the primary hunting grounds. Evenings are centered around warm hospitality, traditional Chilean asados, and generous home-cooked meals paired with fine local wines.

The lodge accommodates up to four guests at a time, including a maximum of two hunters and two non-hunting companions. A variety of activities can be arranged for non-hunters, including horseback riding, hiking, fishing, sightseeing, birdwatching, and scenic helicopter flights.

GETTING THERE

International guests typically arrive through Santiago International Airport (SCL), which is served by direct flights from major cities in the United States and Europe.

From Santiago, guests take an approximately 1½-hour domestic flight to Osorno Airport (ZOS). Upon arrival, lodge staff will meet guests at the airport and provide ground transportation to the ranch. The drive takes approximately 1½ hours and follows scenic roads with beautiful views of the Andes.

Private helicopter transfers between Osorno Airport and the ranch can also be arranged, reducing travel time to approximately 20 minutes.



THE HUNTING

Although the hunting season in this region runs from early March through late April, our program is limited to the peak of the rut, which typically occurs from late March to early April. During this carefully managed period, we harvest only approximately eight mature stags each season, helping preserve the quality and long-term health of the herd. All hunts are guided on a one-to-one basis, with the ranch owner serving as head guide and host. His intimate knowledge of the property, the terrain, and the animals is central to the experience.

Mornings begin well before daylight with breakfast at the lodge, followed by a short drive to the designated hunting area before sunrise. The hunting grounds are conveniently located, with travel times generally under 30 minutes. The ranch has an extensive and well-maintained road system, and 4WD vehicles are used for most access. Horses are also available for reaching more remote areas or for guests who prefer to hunt on horseback. Final stalks are always completed on foot.

Classic spot-and-stalk is the primary hunting method for rifle hunters. Strategically positioned European-style elevated stands also provide opportunities for still hunting in selected areas. Depending on conditions, bowhunters may hunt near wallows and watering areas while waiting for a mature stag to approach.

Guests generally hunt until mid-morning before returning to the lodge for lunch and time to rest. The afternoon hunt begins later in the day and continues until dusk, followed by cocktails, dinner, and a relaxing evening at the lodge.

Our strict herd-management program focuses exclusively on fully mature stags that have reached or passed the peak of their reproductive lives. Following the hunt, we handle all basic trophy preparation in accordance with international export requirements.

Chile does not use a trophy point-scale pricing system for this program. The hunt is offered at a flat rate, regardless of the size of the stag harvested. The ranch also supports healthy populations of fallow deer and mouflon sheep, providing additional hunting opportunities subject to availability.



These Chilean stags are entirely wild, and every hunt is conducted under true fair-chase conditions on an unfenced ranch. With no more than eight mature stags harvested each year, hunting opportunities are extremely limited and highly sought after.

INCLUDED

Round-trip transfers from Osorno Airport (ZOS), shared-room accommodations, all meals, wine and beer, one-to-one guiding, hunting License & Tag, basic trophy preparation, and one red stag trophy with no size limit.

NOT INCLUDED

Airfare; gratuities for guides, skimmers, and lodge staff; rifle rental and ammunition; firearm import permits; additional trophies; trophy export documentation and sanitary certificates; trophy shipping; sightseeing tours, fishing excursions, and other optional activities; personal expenses; excess baggage charges; personal and baggage insurance; costs resulting from itinerary changes requested by the guest; and transfers and hotel accommodations in Santiago.

PAYMENT TERMS

A 50% non-refundable deposit is required within 14 days of booking. The remaining balance is due 90 days prior to arrival. As a small operation that books far in advance, all payments are non-refundable. However, if we are able to resell the cancelled dates, the amount recovered will be applied as a credit toward a future trip. We strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance.
