**R**ed Stag Patagonia is proud to present this hunting program on one of the top Red Stag preserves in South America. Owned by a pioneering Mendoza native, your hosts have been breeding and managing Red Deer herds for the last 20 years. By inter-breeding local stock with some of the best bloodlines from Europe and New Zealand, today they oversee some of the biggest and healthiest herds in the country.

Hunters stay at Atamisque Lodge located on a famous winery very close to the hunting ranch. For small groups we also offer accommodations at the main ranch house. Red Stag Patagonia also offers non-hunting activities, including wine tours and horseback riding for interested guests and groups.

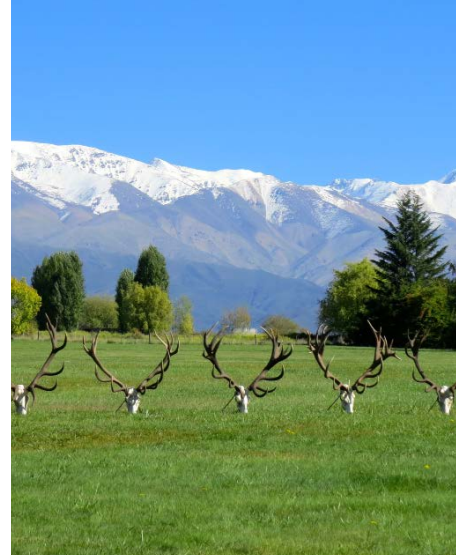
The exclusive preserve spans 20,000 acres and sits on the mid-upper levels of a vast ranch (150,000 acres). On the lower grounds, the family produce potatoes, cherries, walnuts and a small winery. The property is set against a backdrop of some of the highest peaks in the Andes. Mount Tupungato, visible from every corner of the ranch, is one of the highest volcanoes in the world.

The fertile valleys of the Mendoza Andean foothills provide great habitat for deer that have developed impressive racks, with some specimens naturally reaching the 400 SCI+ class. Stags of this size are typically only found in breeding farms in New Zealand and Europe.

## LOCATION



- The ranch is located in the Tupungato region, in the province of Mendoza.
- 85 Kilometers (50 miles) south of the Mendoza airport
- Is one of the biggest and oldest working ranches in western Argentina.
- This 150.000 acre property stretches from the Uco Valley all the way to the highest peaks of the Andes right in the border with Chile.
- The ranch offers amazing views of the Uco Valley where some of the best wineries of Argentina are located.
- Some of the highest peaks in the American Continent are within the ranch- with several near or over 20.000 ft.







## THE HUNTING

- **H**unters depart before dawn, ready to be on ideal glassing spots at day break.
- Horses, ATVs, and 4x4s are used to access hunting areas.
- Drives vary depending on the selected hunting area, but range from 15 to 40 minutes.
- Guiding is one-on-one and all our professional staff speaks English.
- When on horseback, the hunting party is usually escorted by a gaucho (wrangler), who takes care of the horses.
- In the evening we hunt until dark, but with just enough light to get off the mountain safely.
- Depending on the hunting conditions hunters return for lunch and some nap time to the lodge or to the camp right in the hunting area.
- The hunting can be arranged to include hikes into high country looking for lonely big stags or sitting in a blind overlooking a wallow in the valleys or river bottoms.
- On addition to the finest red stag hunting in South America, the ranch has a growing population of fallow deer and every season some beautiful bucks are harvested.
- Pure wild European boar thrive as well in this area-a great addition to the deer.
